AMALFI COAST EXPERIENCE Ravello | Scala | Amalfi

Come and discover the pearls of the Amalfi coast through this hike which joins three of the main cities of the Amalfi coast: Ravello, Scala and Amalfi.

RAVELLO, universally recognized as the city of music, has enchanted and inspired many musicians. Small streets, villas and churches with beautiful mosaics, its atmosphere and the wonderful gardens make it an unforgettable place, an oasis of infinite tranquillity and an ideal place for hikers and trekking lovers. From Ravello we will start our hike walking across SCALA, the most ancient village of the Amalfi Coast, an important stronghold of the ancient Republic of Amalfi. Once, left Scala and its medieval vibes, we are ready to reach AMALFI walking through the "Valle delle Ferriere e dei Mulini." Descending across old paper mills, waterfalls and rare plants, this trail brings you in a totally unusual scenery for the sunny Amalfi coast, a few steps away from the center of the town. Once arrived in Amalfi you will have the chance to fully enjoy the mild Mediterranean climate, taste the typical products and enjoy enchanting views with its Cathedral, numerous churches scattered throughout the territory, and the beautiful landscapes that made this place famous all over the world.

The stunning charm of the island has always enchanted different civilizations, starting from the ancient Greeks, the Romans up to the countless writers and poets of the '900. They brought the island in to the Olympus of the world's destination. Don't miss the chance to see it that with your own eyes!

PATH OF THE GODS



The Path of the Gods takes us back in time, at the glory of the Greek period. Probably one of the most famous paths in Italy, this hike moves from Bomerano to Nocelle. Walking between heaven and earth, from the Path of the Gods it is possible to admire one of the most breathtaking panoramas on Earth: a stunning view of the coast which ranges from the archipelago of Li Galli at your left to the Island of Capri in front of you. The Path of the Gods, despite the name, is also an extraordinary example of the work of human beings, who managed throughout the centuries to colonize even the most impracticable locations of the region. Walking in this spectacular scenery, there will be the occasion to meet local shepherds and farmers eventually. They still work and live in this little corner of heaven facing every day the difficulties of their hard job with passion and devotion, a trademark of the people here in Southern Italy. Through old vineyards, terraces, farmhouses and monasteries, suspended at 650 meters above the sea level, you will have the feeling to walk in a painting with an ever-changing landscape

MONTE FAITO



The lovers of Nature and landscapes can't miss this hike to the highest peaks of the Sorrento Peninsula. Starting from Monte Faito 1200 mt, that overlooks on the gulf of Naples, we will reach Monte Conocchia 1380m and Monte Molare with a height of 1444 m. Your perspective on the beautiful surrounding landscape will change as you gain quote. We will start hiking through a forest of Beeches, chestnut trees and wild orchids in April-May. Then, we reach the roof of the Sorrento's peninsula looking out to the southwindows which give us a stunning view of the Amalfi coast and the gulf of Salerno. There are many beliefs related to these mountains, according to the legends they were the place of retreat and shelter of hermit saints while the collective imagination considered it inhabited by elves and witches. But, what is certain, is that you can relax in the rays of the sun, inhale the sparkling air and enjoy the breathtaking passages, where sky and sea meet in an infinite embrace.

THE PATH OF MINERVAE

Punta Campanella | Monte San Costanzo



Discover the beauties of the landscape immersed in the color palette of the "Macchia Mediterranea" through The Path of Minervae, at the extreme cape of the Sorrento peninsula, From the Piazzetta Santa Croce in Termini we will reach Punta Campanella through the northern side of the promontory Minervae, which separates the Gulf of Naples from the Gulf of Salerno. We will walk along the ancient Via Minerva, a Greek-Roman mule track built in the fourth century B.C. and still partially paved with Roman "basolato." Once reached the Punta Campanella's watchtower, we will have Capri so close (4 km) that you will stretch out your arm to reach it! If you fancy some more walking, from Punta Campanella we hike up to the top of Monte San Costanzo, with the Ieranto Bay on our right and the islands of the bay, Capri, Ischia e Procida, on the left. Hiking in this land full of history and legends, which talks us about Mermaids, Pirates and Witches, we will conquer the peak of the Monte San Costanzo with its white Chapel. That is where you will enjoy a 360° View of the SyrenLand!









So far from the madding crowd yet so close to the centre of it all! Entire families are involved in the cultivation of vegetables, olives, fruits, lemons and the production of jams, oil, limoncello and mozzarella.

Come with us to visit Piano di Sorrento, this little pearl of the gulf of Sorrento, located on a natural terrace between the sea and the mountains. With its commercial vocation, Piano di Sorrento has always been a bustling trading centre for the entire Sorrento area. The cradle of countless craftsmen still carry out today the traditions of the place with commitment and devotion. We will begin our tour from the market square visiting the historic fish and fruit market, a neighbourhood theatre where, every day, the lively and unbridled buying and selling of the products is staged. Walking across the historic center we will visit a factory which still employs the artisanal coffee roasting. Here the experience gained in over 100 years of activity is combined with passion to give life to precious blends with a unique aroma. After the tasting of the bitter aroma of the traditional Neapolitan coffee let's sweeten it up! We will visit a chocolate factory and a honey house that still produces honey in the authentic, old ways. Last but not least, we cannot skip a visit to a typical farm in the middle of a huge lemon and orange garden and discover all their production. Here you can taste one of the local product liqueurs such as the "Limoncello" the true scent of this land.
